

Dr.Omkar Yadav MBA- 2008-2010

Dr. Omkar Yadav: From Snake Charmers to New Species – A Herpetologist's Return to the Wild

Dr. Omkar Yadav's profound journey into the world of herpetology began in the humble weekly markets of Ajara, where the captivating performances of snake charmers first ignited a lifelong fascination. This early interest, nurtured through keen observation and extensive reading, initially took a detour into the corporate realm after an MBA from KBPIMSR, Satara. Yet, the call of the wild proved stronger than the allure of marketing, drawing him back to his true passion with renewed vigor. Today, Dr. Yadav, an Assistant Professor, not only inspires a research-driven mindset in his students but actively contributes to scientific discovery, regularly unveiling new species.

Born on November 2, 1986, in Arjunwada, Kolhapur, Omkar's early education spanned various talukas due to his father's government transfers. It was during his primary schooling in Ajara that his deep interest in reptiles took root, flourishing through visits to Amboli's forests and local reptile exhibitions. While initially aspiring to join the army, his love for biology, particularly reptiles, steered him towards a Zoology degree at Vivekanand College, Kolhapur. During this period, daily commutes through the region sparked his commitment to wildlife research and conservation. He began snake rescue work, connected with like-minded individuals such as Nilesh Patil, and found a mentor in Sunil Karkare, Kolhapur's honorary wildlife warden. His holidays were spent observing wildlife in Radhanagari Sanctuary, further cementing his dedication. After a brief stint in marketing post-MBA, Omkar realized his true calling lay elsewhere. He returned to academia, pursuing

postgraduate studies in Zoology at Shivaji University. This period proved transformative, as interactions with renowned herpetologists like Dr. Varad Giri shaped his academic path. Under the guidance of Dr. S. R. Yankanchi, he embarked on his Ph.D. in anuran biodiversity, a journey that included rigorous training at the DST-sponsored Herp-School, where he met global experts. Completing his Ph.D. on Kolhapur's frog biodiversity in 2017, followed by qualifying SET and NET exams, paved his way to professorship.

Currently, Dr. Omkar Yadav serves as an Assistant Professor at Amdar Shashikant Shinde College in Medha. Here, he not only imparts knowledge but also mentors aspiring researchers like Satpal Gangalmale and Saurabh Kininge. Despite his teaching responsibilities, his passion for research remains undimmed. He has an impressive publication record, with 32 papers in international journals and two books. To date, Dr. Yadav has described two new species of frogs, two new species of land snails, and one new species of scorpion, with further discoveries awaiting publication. Beyond his scientific contributions, he actively guides students in cultural events, bringing numerous accolades to his college. Dr. Omkar Yadav's journey is a powerful testament to following one's true passion, blending academic rigor with hands-on conservation and inspiring the next generation of environmental stewards.

Tamanna Bera: Striking a Path for Women's Empowerment Through Karate

Tamanna Vijendra Bera, an alumna of KBPIMSR Satara (BBA, 2015), has transformed her passion for Karate into a powerful movement for women's empowerment. Despite facing numerous challenges, her unwavering perseverance has been recognized with prestigious accolades like the RanRagini Puraskar, Hirkani Puraskar, an award from Dadi Chandro Tomar, and recognition from Gujarat Governor Acharya Devvrat Singh for her outstanding contributions.

Defying traditional family customs often restrictive for women in sports, Tamanna bravely forged her path in Karate. During her time in Kuwait, she founded the Tamanna Social Foundation, further extending her commitment to empowering women by creating employment opportunities. Ashwini Shivaji Bhilare: A Journey from Corporate Leadership to Transformative Conservation

A turning point arrived in 2017 when Ashwini connected with the Jeevitnadi Living River Foundation in Pune. Volunteering with the NGO ignited a deep dive into river ecosystems. She meticulously documented biodiversity along the Mutha River, studying its riparian zone and observing seasonal changes. This commitment soon transformed into a weekly ritual of clean-up drives and ecological documentation, inspiring a growing community of volunteers, and even gaining support from the Pune Municipal Corporation.

Ashwini's efforts expanded beyond clean-ups to impactful educational initiatives. She began organizing river walks for college students and delivering lectures at various institutions, educating over 1,000 individuals on river rejuvenation. A significant achievement was the successful revival of a natural wetland at Vitthalwadi, recognized by Wetlands International for its grassroots impact.

Further demonstrating her dedication, Ashwini contributed to a sustainable river restoration project with Oikos, offering an eco-friendly alternative to government plans that threatened ancient trees. This alternative approach was not only environmentally sound but also significantly more cost-effective. Her unwavering commitment was celebrated in 2024 with the "Samarasta Puraskar," a deeply personal acknowledgment of her individual contributions.

Today, Ashwini continues her multifaceted conservation work, combining biodiversity and wildlife photography with wetland development, river walks, and ecological assessments as a freelancer. Her transformative journey from the corporate world to a leading voice in environmental activism stands as an inspiring testament to dedication and passion, aiming for a future where healthy rivers and thriving ecosystems are a reality.
