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"A Chronicle of Lifelong Learning: Navigating Career Peaks and Educational Valleys"

Embarking on the journey of life after college, I found myself immersed in a prestigious and fast-paced career. The initial decade was a symphony of settling down, a crescendo that laid the foundation for my desire to delve deeper into the realms of knowledge. The subsequent four to two years were marked by contemplation, a reflective pause to discern which educational avenue would harmonize with my inherent nature. Amidst this contemplation, I briefly explored the terrain of population science journalism—a venture abandoned halfway due to its lack of conviction and resonance.

In a serendipitous twist of fate, an advertisement for a one-year DBM (Diploma in Business Management) course in management surfaced during my tenure at the Satara Collector's Office. This unexpected encounter prompted a hurried admission, met with quizzical expressions from onlookers questioning the rationale behind such a struggle at this stage of life.

The faculty, under the banner of Anna, proved to be not only extensive but also noble-minded. Their commitment was a testament to the idea of instilling quality management concepts in a resource-constrained environment. Dr. Bhosale's expertise in HR, Dr. Bholia's comprehensive vision of the management sector, and Dr. Sawant's unwavering support constituted a phase that infused immense joy into my newfound student life.

Completing the diploma in a mere eight to ten months, I found myself encouraged by mentors like Dr. Sawant to pursue an MBA rather than halting at that juncture. Armed with information about a quality MBA college in Pune, I undertook the daunting task of preparing for and qualifying the MBA entrance exam of Symbiosis University. Anticipating this success, I had already orchestrated a transfer to the Pune Collector's Office.

However, the commencement of the MBA program ushered in a whirlwind of challenges—overloaded work in Pune, navigating daily traffic snarls, and the picturesque yet demanding landscape of Lavale, a village 30 km west of Pune. A motorcycle became my trusty companion for almost two and a half years, facilitating my journey through strict weekend classes and copious amounts of homework. The strict discipline of the course, extreme weather conditions, and the unrelenting demands of the office created an internal dialogue about the true nature of my pursuit. Yet, the respite lay in the high-quality education offered by these prestigious institutions—a sanctuary of knowledge with international standing, erudite lecturers, and well-equipped libraries.

Post-MBA, uncertainty loomed regarding the next step. A realization during HR studies that psychology significantly influenced the field prompted a decision to pursue education in psychology. A stroke of luck led me to join the second year of BA in the psychology department of Wadia College, just a stone's throw away from home and office.

The faculty, close friends of KBP, motivated me to embark on a Ph.D. journey. Attempts at entrance exams in Pune and Shivaji University bore no fruit, but success came in the form of the M.Phil. entrance exam of Shivaji University.

Rejoining KBPIMSR, this time, the college had evolved, boasting its own well-equipped building, grounds, labs, and a library. The academic voyage took a turn towards a different topic within HR, guided by Dr. Bholia's suggestion to select a subject for the initial two to three months. Thus, the intriguing realm of Interprofessional Leadership became the focus. The motorcycle journeys transformed into distant Saturday and Sunday Pune-Satara ST travels, supplemented by visits to the University of Kolhapur and rounds in the MIDCs of the district for data collection.

Amidst this intricate tapestry, the M.Phil. degree was achieved by crafting a dissertation that brought satisfaction both to myself and the academic timeline. With the seven to eight-year period drawing to a close, the resolve to pursue a Ph.D. from the highest institution took root. Fueled by M.Phil. experience and guided studies, I qualified for the Ph.D. entrance exam. As the journey unfolded, the initial chapters of the Ph.D. were prepared with ease. Dr. Prafulla Pawar, the guide and the Registrar of Pune University, facilitated coordinated efforts, providing deep instructions with unwavering effort. However, halfway through the journey, a promotion to Additional Collector and a transfer to Nandurbar, a remote tribal area 400 kilometers away, disrupted the seamless progression of my Ph.D. work. Amidst the challenges posed by a limited internet connection, library resources, and research-minded colleagues, progress in Nandurbar was compromised. The unrelenting demands of district-wide planning in Dhule, coupled with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, intensified the hurdles. The pessimistic thought that most aspirants would be unable to complete their Ph.D. took root. Overcoming these hurdles, after five years, the thesis was finally submitted to the university, marking the culmination of an arduous yet fulfilling educational journey. Education, in the true sense of the management field, became an opus of perseverance.

In this extensive journey spanning almost two decades, I forged meaningful connections in the field of education, weathering joys and sorrows with colleagues like Mrs. Sujata and receiving unwavering support from Brother Arun.






