Tasty Food Plaza (TFP) was started three years ago, and currently has a workforce of 150 people. Customers rated the services as extremely efficient. The governing board has decided to double the capacity of TFP. The Executive Officer, Lolo, feels that TFP will lose its efficiency because of the proposed increase in capacity. She met the chairman and said, "I want people who are just like our existing team of people- hardworking, dedicated, talented, and able to interact well with customers. If we increase the number of employees, I am afraid, how it will be possible to maintain quality of service. We will lose our family atmosphere and will become like our other competitors in the local area-large and uncaring."

The chairman Mr. D'Castabelieves that Lolo is over-reacting. "It would not be difficult to find people who are like existing staff There is a need to develop an action plan for careful screening of probable people who will fit into current organisational culture." As a result of the chairman's view, Lolo had decided to develop an action plan.
